This permit is issued subject to the directions, restrictions and conditions contained herein and on the reverse of this form and any attachments hereto, and covers only the work described in this application, and only when the work is performed as directed. Upon failure of a person or corporation to perform such work in a manner satisfactory to the Selectboard, the Selectboard may complete such work at the expense of the person or corporation and recover such expense in an action of tort on this statute, in the name of the Town of Grand Isle, with costs (Title 19 V.S.A. Section 1525).

The applicant agrees to perform such work in a manner satisfactory to the Selectboard of the Town of Grand Isle and to adhere to the directions, restrictions, and conditions forming a part of this permit.

1. Jack/bore for road cuts if possible. All road cuts are to be compacted in 6" steps to 95% compaction.
2. Pipe to be laid within right-of-way and will be located approximately 20' from center of road right-of-way. Property shutoffs and blow offs will be located approximately 10' from edge of highway. No pipe laid will interfere with future ditching of town highways.
3. Contractor/applicant will be responsible for settlement in road cuts and shoulders for 1 year from acceptance.
4. Proper work area signage will be installed before beginning project.
5. Contractor/applicant must contact 24 hours in advance – Grand Isle Public Works Supervisor, the Grand Isle Volunteer Fire Department and Grand Isle Rescue in the event of a road closing.
6. Contactor/applicant will post a public notice in "The Islander" (local newspaper) to inform residents of possible delays and/or road closure.
7. Contractor/applicant must leave 24-hour emergency contact telephone numbers with Public Works Supervisor at 372-4863.
8. All road cuts with mirafi under base of road will be patched with mirafi. Disturbed mirafi will be straight cut on each edge and patched with a 2' overlay on each edge of existing mirafi.
